QUALITY

Y child care is licensed by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services. Our school-age centers have been awarded, or are in the process of being awarded, Step Up To Quality recognition which is a voluntary rating system recognizing care programs that exceed Ohio's licensing standards.

CONVENIENT

Centers are open from 6:30am-6:00pm. Advanced reservations are available for Holidays, School's Out and Snow Days. YMCA Members & Full time child care registrants are given priority for care on schools out days/holidays, delays, snow days, and school cancellations.

YMCA CHILD CARE CLOSES ON THESE DAYS:

WEEKLY FEES:

Full Time Weekly Rate (4-5 days):

Before school \$50

After school \$75

Before & After \$95

Part-Time Weekly Rate (1-3 days):

Before school \$40

After school \$65

Before & After \$75

One Time Registration Fee:

\$30/Child \$35/Family

Full Time Care is 4-5 days per week & allows for flexibility to come any days. Part time care is 1-3 days and requires the same days to be requested every week per our ODJFS guidelines. Public Funding (Title XX) available are based on full time attendance. YMCA Member discounts will be applied for active memberships. The YMCA of Greater Dayton accepts convenient payment options of credit cards or automatic payment plans.

Holidays/Snow Days/School's Out/ In-service Days - \$35. It is an additional fee per child, per day for each day in attendance during these days. This is in addition to the weekly fees and is available for the children in our childcare program. Fees are not prorated based on attendance. Schools out weekly rate is \$150. Public Funds are accepted. (TXX)
